Ealing picks up LTT local authority cycle-rail award | [edit](#)

The Ealing Broadway Cycle Hub won the LTT-sponsored award for the best local government scheme at the annual cycle-rail awards ceremony in London last week. The judges, who included LTT's editor, considered this an impressive project, providing two types of facility in a limited space, and they also applauded Ealing's "joined-up marketing and communication with local retailers and bike shops". Ealing invested £600,000 on four new cycle shelters giving 232 square metres of cover, a new integrated taxi shelter, a Brompton cycle dock and 170 new cycle
